



ISEqH Site visits

In association with the International Society for Equity in Health's Fourth International Conference, *Creating Healthy Societies through Inclusion and Equity*, two site visits reflecting themes explored in the conference are being offered on **Thursday 14th September**.

Focus: Indigenous health

Trip 1 will take participants on a day trip out of Adelaide to Murray Bridge, about an hours drive east of Adelaide, to visit a Primary Health Care service at a community centre. From there the tour will continue to the Coorong Wilderness Lodge for lunch and the opportunity to learn about the culture of the Ngarrindjeri people including a 'bush tucker' (indigenous foods) interpretive walk. The Lodge offers spectacular views of the surrounding waters and native bushland. In the afternoon the tour will continue to the Raukkan Aboriginal Community, located adjacent to Lake Alexandrina.

Focus: Arts and health

Trip 2 takes participants on an exploration of community arts and health projects in the north western suburbs of Adelaide.

The trip will include a visit to 'The Grove Garden' at a local Primary School where The Parks Helix Project has funded the creation of artistic components on the theme of 'belonging' and a visit to The Children's House at The Parks Community Centre where young parents have worked on creating objects and areas that are welcoming to the community.

Following lunch at the parks Community Centre the tour will proceed to Dale Street Women's Health Centre to explore the way the arts have been used to promote women's health, develop community programs and used in the design of the building itself.
